






The Fordham Rams fell to Yale, 4-3, in the 1973 Eastern Championship falling just shy of their first title

FRANCIS X. JUDGE CUP

The annual contest between New York City rivals, Fordham and Iona has been dubbed the Dr. Francis X. Judge Memorial Cup match in honor of Dr. Francis Judge, a water polo pioneer at Fordham and the founder of the Hudson Valley Water Polo Club.

As a freshman in 1949, Judge brought the sport of Water Polo back to Fordham, serving as a player-coach. He finished his four-year undergraduate stint with a 9-5 overall record and an Eastern Championship. His son, Christopher, also played and coached water polo at Fordham, and his grandsons, Alex and Stephen, also were Rams.

As a member of the New York Athletic Club, Judge won two national championships and participated in the Olympic Trials in 1952. Following two years in dental school at NYU, Judge returned to coach at his alma mater, turning a 3-16 team into a 14-5 squad one season later. He was in inducted into the Fordham University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1985.

In 1975, Dr. Judge founded the Hudson Valley Water Polo Club with the goal of developing youth water polo in the NY metropolitan area. Many of his players went on to successful collegiate careers. In fact, several formed the nucleus of the original club team at Iona College. Three of his sons (Greg, Matt and Ray) played for the first Varsity team at Iona in 1983. In addition, sons Michael and Kevin also played at Iona and served as assistant coaches.


